With that being said, we are planning for a more normal year. Our tax volunteers are getting ready for tax season (with a few precautions in place). We are attending virtual and in person workshops again (with a few precautions in place), and more of our partner agencies are opening their doors for volunteers again (with a few precautions in place). We have exciting news to share for the upcoming tax season. RSVP is partnering with Athens Limestone Public Library this year and tax counselors will be preparing tax returns at the Library. Athens Limestone Public Library is located at 603 South Jefferson Street. You will call RSVP office at 256-232-7207 to make an appointment. No walk-ins this year. You must have an appointment. You will also come by the RSVP office prior to your appointment and pick up a yellow intake form to be completed before your appointment.

Decatur Public Library and Ardmore Library will be open again this year to prepare taxes. You must have an appointment to have your taxes prepared. Call RSVP office to make Decatur appointments and call Ardmore Library 931-427-4883 to make their appointments. Remember you must have an appointment this year to have your taxes prepared at any of our sites.

In practicing social distancing and safe face to face meeting, these are the requirements: must wear a mask and wear it covering your nose and face at all times, wear gloves please, bring your own writing pen to sign documents. Only the taxpayer(s) can come in at scheduled appointment time. If you fail to keep your appointment and do not cancel, you will be rescheduled for the last day if an appointment is available for you. Otherwise, you will need to go to a paid preparer. Bring all required documents with you at your scheduled appointment time.

Due to COVID-19 and practicing of social distancing, there is a strong possibility that RSVP annual recognition lunch will not be held in March. If the Governor and CDC are still encouraging no large gatherings, the luncheon will be rescheduled to a later date. Just stay tuned for that determination at a later date.

We are thankful for all of you who join us on this journey - we have excellent company! RSVP Volunteers are special!! We pray each of you will stay well until you have the opportunity to receive a vaccine. Our prayers and thoughts are with the families of RSVP volunteers who have passed away during these most difficult times. You are in our hearts. 
